## ASH Churchyard Monumental Inscriptions

(not exact wording on stones, but genealogical abstracts, giving all information in a concise form. Exact wording is however given for any in double inverted commas, in a few instances with obliques '/' indicating the ends of lines).

Ash was created as a Chapelry of the Parish of Martock in 1845 (the land having been purchased in 1840 for a new church and burial ground; the church being completed in 1845 - apart from the tower, which was built c1919). Ash was created as a separate parish in 1895, but has, since 1972, been recombined with Martock, as part of the Benefice of Martock. The burial register commences in 1845. The burial ground appears to have been closed to further interments (apart from reserved spaces) in about 1980, as there are no very modern memorials here. All church and churchyard memorials have been recorded.

### Churchyard. North of the Church

(recorded in rows from west to east).

- 1). Small Headstone. David WARREN "gardener at Ash House", died 3 April 1871, aged 23
- 2). Cross (shaft broken off and vanished). Catherine, wife of John F. LOCK, of Charlton Musgrove, died 1 Feb 1878, aged 34.
- 3). Cross. John Seymour MOREY, died 28 Nov 1914, aged 65. And his wife Matilda, died peacefully 15 June 1936, aged 85.
- 4). Headstone. Sarah, widow of James WILSON, Lieut: R.N. died 1 July 1878, at Stapleton, Martock, aged 80.
- 5). Cross (shaft broken off, leaning on the base). Jane MOREY, of Milton Falconbridge, died 27 June 1937, aged 79, widow of William Stickland Morey.
- 6). Cross, Open Book and kerb. George HODGES, died 26 July 1909, aged 67. And his wife Eliza, died 18 March 1943, aged 95. Also their son, Robert Hodges, killed in France, Sept 1918. And their daughter, Prudence DAVIS (surname?), died Oct 1918 (PR: not buried here). Open Book: William John "Bill" RUNDLE, of this parish, died 13 Feb 1978, aged 77. And his wife Ella Pursey "Pearl" Rundle, died 29 Aug 1982.
- 7). Cross. Mary MOREY, died 27 April 1878, aged 36.
- 8). Small Headstone. Levi John PEARCE, born 27 June 1842, died 15 Oct 1877.
- 9). Headstone. John CRIBB, died 12 Feb 1883, aged 66. And his wife Mary, died 6 July 1867, aged 48. Also their son, William, died 23 Aug 1883, aged 28. And their grandson, William Walter John WORNER, died 23 Feb 1863 (1883?), aged 3 years and 11 months (PR: probably not buried here, as not found in 1863. In 1883 he might be, though unlikely: "William Indoe Worner", buried 2 Feb 1883, aged 3 years). Also "the fifth son of the above", Edward Perren Cribb, died 23 March 1884, aged 25.
- 10). Kerb. Annie Mary LANGRIDGE, died 26 May 1954, aged 77.
- 11). Headstone (surmounted by a cross; worn lower down due to having broken and then been repaired). William ABBOTT, of Stapleton, died 20 Oct 1863, aged 54. And his wife Lucy Abbott, died 7 May 1883, aged ..... (illegible; PR: aged 76).
- 12). Headstone (surmounted by a cross) and kerb. Edith Christina, wife of F.J.H. HAWKINS, daughter of Revd: C.C. SOUTHEY, M.A. "many years Vicar of Kingsbury Episcopi", and granddaughter of Robert Southey "late Poet Laureate", born 26 Dec 1844, died 14 May 1901 (Note: her sister Bertha, who died in 1918, aged 70, is buried in Martock churchyard).
- 13). Cross and kerb. Arthur Alexander WILKIE, died 15 May 1907, aged 71 (PR: aged 72) And his wife Laura Wilkie, died 5 Dec 1921, at Bath, aged 76. (see also no.114)
- 14). Headstone (surmounted by a cross) and kerb. Eliza, widow of William Scudder OSBALDESTON "whose remains are interred at Kensal Green Cemetery, London". She died 6 Feb 1889, aged 85. And her sister, Mary HEBDITCH, daughter of "the late George and Mary LOCK, of Witcombe", died 26 July 1904, aged 89 (PR: as Mary Hebditch, aged 90).

- 15). Headstone (surmounted by a cross, engulfed in ivy) and kerb. Jane, wife of James HILL, died 13 March 1880, aged 78. And their daughter, Sarah, died 26 Oct 1861, aged 23. Also Ellen SMITH (PR: this is her surname), daughter of the above Jane Hill, died 27 Dec 1898, aged 67.
- 16). Headstone (surmounted by a cross). Ellen CARTER, died 6 July 1905, aged 45. And her husband Charles Carter, died 2 July 1918, aged 62? (worn) (PR: aged 66).
- 17). Flat Ledger stone. Rachel, wife of Revd: W.H. BRAUND, died 8 Dec 1861, aged 58. And Revd: W.H. Braund, died 21? Nov 1875, aged 69. (PR: Revd: William Hockin Braund, buried 26 Nov 1875) (see also no. 108) (Note: a raised flatstone close by, has traces of wording on the top, but is now illegible).
- 18). Coped Stone. Caroline TRIST, died 17 April 1861, aged 74.
- 19). Cross and kerb. Selena, widow of Hickman KEARNEY, born 16 April 1818, died 22 Jan 1891.
- 20). Headstone (surmounted by a cross). Peter HODGES, died 6 Oct 1868, aged 57. And his son, Edward Hodges "A.I.C.E. late Executive Engineer, Indian P.W.D.I", died 8 Dec 1892, at Naini Tal (India?), aged 49.
- 21). Headstone and Kerb. kerb: Mary A. TUCKER, died 16 June 1905, aged 75. And George Tucker, died 7 Feb 1917, aged 81. Also Rhoda MIDDLETON, died 18 Sep 1905, aged 51. And Robert Middleton, died 28 Sept 1917, aged 65. Also Emily A. Tucker, died 1 May 1946, aged 79. And Frederick J. Tucker, died 5 Jan 1894, aged 24. headstone: 'my wife' Violet Rhoda DEACON, daughter of John and Elizabeth ORAM, died 24 Feb 1957, aged 40. And John Oram, died 19 Nov 1974, aged 84. Also Elizabeth Ann Oram, died 14 June 1983, aged 91.
- 22). Headstone (cracking, flaking, most of the right-hand portion of it is missing). left column: "Sacred/ to the memory of/ William WORNER/ who departed this/ life September 16th./ 1848, aged 67 years/ Also/ Mary Worner/ wife of the above/ William Worner/ who departed this life/ November 13th. 1860. aged/ aged (sic) 76 years/ Also/ Catherine Newport/ Worner, daughter of/ Octavius and Jane/ Worner, born May 18th./ 1855, died April 10th. 1857/ aged 1 year 11 months/ Also Newport John/ Worner, broth(er) .... (2 lines flaked)". fragments of right column: (PR: these presumably refer to Octavius Worner, buried 25 Nov 1897, aged 77, and Jane Worner, buried 22 June 1907, aged 86, and 5 children died in infancy) "loving...../ Octa(vius?) .... / who (died?) the.../ 1897...../ a...../ Jane...../ wife of...../ who f(ell asleep?)...../ June ...../ aged ...../ Also five ...../ died in ....."
- 23). Headstone (surmounted by a cross). Ann LOCK, of Witcombe, Martock, died 31 Jan 1893, aged 68. And her husband Thomas Bishop Lock, died 26 April 1904, aged 81. Also their son, George Bishop Lock, died 29 Aug 1909, aged 51.
- 24). Headstone (leaning backwards). William LOCK, of Milton, Martock, died 19 Feb 1884, aged 29. And his wife Mary A. Lock, died 11 April 1907, aged 45.
- 25). Headstone (flaking badly). "Sacred/ to the memory of/ Mary ..... of/ Geo(rge) LOCK/ ..... this life/ ..... aged 73 years/ Christopher Lock/ son? of the above George/ and Mary Lock, who died/ September 20th. 1861, aged 33 y(ears)/ Also George Lock, husba(nd)/ of the above Mary Lock, w(ho)/ died March 27th. 1867, aged 87 ye(ars)" (PR: Mary Lock, buried 1 Sept 1852, aged 72).
- 26). Headstone. Nancy, wife of the late William Pipe PAINE, of Milton Falconbride (sic), "third daughter of the late George and Mary LOCK, of Witcombe", died 22 Dec 1876?, aged 68 (PR: Nancy Paine, buried 30 Dec 1876, aged 68).
- 27). Coped Stone, surrounded by a kerb and low iron railings. Arthur Bedford PEPPIN, died 9 Oct 1852, aged 66. And his wife Caroline, died 27 Jan 1876, aged 79. (see also no. 111)
- 28). Headstone and kerb. John ENGLAND, died 16 March 1917, aged 66. And his wife Charlotte Moss (PR: her surname was England), died 30 June 1930, aged 75.
- 29). Remnant of a Headstone (top broken off and vanished, bottom part fracturing and flaking). "..... Feb: ... 184-...../ Elizabeth, wife (of?).../ Joseph ISAAC/ who died Decr: 24th. 1854, aged 88/ Also John, son of Joseph and/ Elizabeth Isaac/ (who)... died Augst: 15th. 1859/ aged 62 years" (PR: first person recorded is Joseph Isaac, buried 1 March 1848, aged 82; John Isaac given as aged 61).

- 30). Headstone (leaning ominously forward, though it didn't fall on me!), and Kerb. William SHIPP, died 13 Feb 1901, aged 72. And his son, Edwin C. Shipp, died 18 July 1900, aged 32. Also Sarah Jane Shipp, died 5 June 1910, aged 77. And Fanny J. GRANT, daughter of Sarah J. Shipp, died 7 April 1937, aged 71. Kerb: Benjamin Cecil Shipp, died 10 Feb 1951, aged 76.
- 31). Headstone. 'wife and mother' Alice MIDDLETON, died 14 Sept 1950, aged 71. And her husband Albert Edward, died 26 July 1973, aged 94.
- 32). Remnant of a Headstone (top broken off and vanished, bottom part fracturing and flaking; engulfed in ivy). "...of/ Henry HODDINOTT/ who died Novr: 10th. 1859/ aged 24 years" (PR: the person buried here is Henry Hoddinott).
- 33). Headstone (surmounted by a cross). Mary, wife of Benjamin HODGES, died 25 June 1870, aged 24.
- 34). Three coffin-shaped Coped Stones, all surrounded by a kerb and low iron railings:
  - a). Grace STUCKEY, died 21 April 1865, aged 55. And her husband Walter Stuckey, died 5 Oct 1871, aged 61. (see also no. 106).
  - b). Lieutenant John BOWDEN, R.N. died 2 Aug 1855, aged 64. And his wife Anne, died 27 June 1884, aged 83.
  - c). Robert LUCAS, died 2 Oct 1851, aged 42. And his widow, Mary, died 24 Dec 1872, aged 69.

East of the Church

- 35). Headstone. Elizabeth Ann, wife of Edwin HEAD, died 25 Oct 1885, aged 37.
- 36). Cross (shaft broken off, lying alongside). Arthur George, son of ('George' altered to) 'Edwin' and Elizabeth HEAD, died 10 June 1882, aged 4 years. And their infant daughter, Annie, died 15 June 1882.
- 37). Displaced Flower Holder. Mervyn Peter BURGE, aged 2 years (undated, PR: buried in 1956, day and month not given).

South Side of the Church Tower

(there are no memorials south of the church itself)

- 38). On a pile of displaced kerb stones, stacked against the south wall of the church tower are two kerbs bearing inscriptions, and a displaced open book:
  - a). kerb. William John REYLAND, died 25 Aug 1946, aged 72.
  - b). kerb (no date, c1950). Ann SARGENT, aged 86 (PR: this might be Elizabeth Ann England Sargent, buried 6 Aug 1947, aged 81).

- 42). Flower Holder. Albert BATTY (undated; PR: buried 2 Dec 1957, aged -- (blank)).
- 43). Sloping Stone and kerb. Norah Kathleen JACOBS, died 13 July 1958. And her husband John Robert Jacobs, died 18 Jan 1976.
- 44). Small Cross. Douglas Holt, child of J.R. and N.K. JACOBS, died 27 July 1915, aged 16 months.
- 45). Sloping Stone. Henry Gifford BARWOOD, Vicar of Ash and Long Load, 1959 - 1971. (see also no. 105)

West of the Church

- 46). Wooden Cross with brass plate fixed to it. Bertha Elizabeth BRYANT, born 23 April 1893, died 3 March 1979. And Richard Harold Bryant, born 29 April 1893, died 10 March 1980.

- 49). Flower Holder. Bert TUCKER, died 10 Oct 1958, aged 49.

- 51). Sloping Stone (in the form of a scroll). Susan Margaret NORMAN, died 9 March 1925, aged 84.
- 52). Cross. Jemima R. PEACH, died 2 Sept 1914, aged 61. And Alice Richards Peach, died 5 May 1947, aged 85.
- 53). Small Headstone (surmounted by a cross). Arthur John GERRISH, died 25 May 1911, aged 20. And Robert George Gerrish, died 8 Sept 1911, aged 2 years and 9 months
- 54). Kerb. Harriett Ada SEALEY, died 7 March 1953, aged 84.
- 55). Sloping Stone (in the form of a scroll). Walter MORTON, died 2 Oct 1918, aged 70.
- 56). Displaced Heart-shaped Sloping Stone (broken into two pieces, lying on top of no.55). Nancy, widow of Christopher LOCK, of Witcombe, died 21 June 1922, in her 90th year.
- 57). Cross and kerb. William WORNER, died 26 Jan 1915, aged 68. And his wife Ann Maria Worner, died 7 July 1947, aged 99. Also their daughter, Matilda Annie Worner, died 10 Jan 1954, aged 77. And their son, William Edward Worner, died 4 Aug 1956, aged 66. Also their daughter, Mary Maude LEMON (PR: this is her surname), died 19 Dec 1960, aged 86.
- 58). Headstone. William MOUNTER, died 21 Jan 1947. And his wife Florence, died 4 Dec 1981, aged 84.
- 59). Cross and kerb. Harold E. ROWSWELL, died 19 Dec 1918, aged 10 years. And Edith Hilda Rowswell, died 22 Dec 1918, aged 2 years. Also their parents: Edward Rowswell, died 3 Jan 1963, and Anna Evelyn Rowswell, died 16 March 1968.
- 60). Headstone. Ann GOODING, died 15 Sept 1919, aged 80.
- 61). Cross. Mary CULLIFORD, died 4 May 1920, aged 73. And her husband Henry Culliford, died 4 Oct 1925, aged 77.
- 62). Cross (shaft broken off, lying alongside). Elizabeth, wife of William SPILLER, died 18 Sept 1920, aged 75. And William Seymour Spiller, died 15 May 1935, aged 88.
- 63). Flower Holder (undated, c1930). 'mother and father' Emma and Alfred FRAMPTON.
- 64). Cross and Kerb. Samuel A.R. PEACH, of Manor Farm, Milton, died 27 June 1926, aged 72. And his wife Elizabeth, died 5 Jan 1903, aged 53. kerb: And Robert William, "son of S. and E. Peach", died 3 July 1941, aged 54.
- 65). Cross. James CHISLETT, died 22 Jan 1927, aged 63. And his niece, Nellie RAYSON, died 1 Nov 1936, aged 20.
- 66). Headstone. Robert Arthur BURGE, died April 1925, aged 4 years. And his mother, Helen Burge, died 7 Feb 1966, aged 79. Also Arthur Thomas Burge, died 21 March 1967, aged 78.
- 67). Kerb. John BECKEY, died 9 Feb 1926, aged 64. And his wife Alice, died 23 Sept 1938, aged 81. Also Cpl: Arthur Beckey, 7th. S.L.I., killed in action 8 May 1916, aged 25.
- 68). Sloping Stone and kerb. 'our father and mother' Thomas Perren LOOK, died 17 Oct 1927, aged 47, and Ethel Beatrice Look, died 30 June 1941, aged 62.

  - 81). Flower Holder and Kerb. 'wife and mother' Marina ORAM, died 11 June 1936, aged 74. And her husband James Oram, died 19 April 1944, aged 82. kerb: Also Emma Laura Oram, died 31 Dec 1979, aged 78.
  - 82). Kerb. Edith Lily MARGERY (PR: this is her surname), died 13 Aug 1957, aged 80 (PR: aged 78).
  - 83). Headstone and kerb. Emily Ann ENGLAND, died 21 Dec 1934, aged 79. And her sister, Mary Matilda LEMON, died 12 April 1909, aged 49.
  - 84). Low Headstone and kerb. William COCKRAM, died 18 Aug 1940, aged 77. And his wife Edith Eliza, died 22 Feb 1970, aged 100 years.
  - 85). Wooden Cross (very worn). .....(Gertrude) Annie SYMES, died 5 Jan 1941 (PR: Gertrude Annie Symes, buried 9 Jan 1941, aged 68).
  - 86). Coped Stone. Georgina Sarah Stuart SNELL, 1867 - 1942.
  - 87). Headstone. 'husband and father' Tom Henry BUSH, died 25 Jan 1972, aged 86. And 'wife and mother' Beatrice Mary Bush, died 10 Dec 1974, aged 93.
  - 88). Headstone and kerb. 'father and mother' Ephraim England BUSH, died 8 July 1944, aged 88, and Mary Alice Bush, died 18 Nov 1954, aged 89.
  - 89). Headstone. Cecil Arthur BOWDITCH, 1884 - 1944. And his wife Ada Annie Bowditch, 1877 - 1974.
  - 90). Kerb. Harold James JEANES, died 22 Sept 1943, aged 69.

- 105). Brass plate on organ. Organ restored in 1973, in memory of Henry Gifford BARWOOD, M.B.E., M.A., Vicar of Ash and Long Load, 1959 - 1971. (see also no.45)
- 106). White marble tablet on south wall. Grace STUCKEY, died 21 April 1865, aged 55. And her husband Walter Stuckey, died 5 Oct 1871, aged 61. (see also no.34a).
- 107). War Memorial (framed glazed parchment roll), on south wall. 1914 - 1919: Arthur BECKEY and Robert HODGES. 1939 - 1945: William Ernest WORNER; Leonard Thomas BUSH and Frederick STACEY.
- 108). White on black marble tablet on north wall. Elizabeth, eldest daughter of the late James HEARN, Esq; and Ann his wife, of Shillhouse, Shebbear, Devon, died "at the house of her brother-in-law" Revd: William Hockin BRAUND, M.A. Incumbent of this church, 15 June 1849, aged 72.
- 109). Brass (mounted on wood) plaque on north wall. 'my husband' John Robert LEMON, Churchwarden here, Easter 1915 - Easter 1925, died 27 Sept 1933, aged 71.
- 110). Brass plaque on north wall. Lilian Mary ROWE, of Milton Llanishen, Cardiff, wife of Albert Gordon Rowe, daughter of William and Mary Ann LOCK, of this parish. She died Sunday, 9 Nov 1919, aged 36. Her body was cremated at Golders Green, London, and the ashes dispersed 13 Nov 1919. Monument erected by her husband, and her brother William Lock.
- 111). White on grey marble tablet on north wall. Arthur Bedford PEPPIN, "formerly of the Honourable East India Company's Service, and Garrison Surgeon at Trichinopoly", died 9 Oct 1852, aged 66. And his wife Caroline, died 27 Jan 1876, aged 79. (see also no.27).
