- Family Christmas Walk Around the Christmas Decorated Millennium Wood (with a Surprise Visitor and Magical Wish Tree)

Covid-19 has also had a massive impact on the church's income. Not only because of the closure of the church during lockdown, but also the cancellation of the Wednesday coffee mornings and now the Christmas Sale, which together usually contribute around £3000 per year to our funds.
